## **General Rules and Regulations**

ARRIVAL

06:45 - 07:30

Parents are requested to accompany their children to the front door on arrival and fetch them at the front door. No child will be allowed in the school before 06:45. No child may be dropped off in the parking area. If a driver drops your child, the driver is responsible to accompany your child to the front door.

#### BREAKFAST

All children who arrive from 06:45 - 07:15 will receive a bowl of porridge. No breakfast will be served after 07:15

#### FRONT DOOR:

Please use the front entrance next to the secretary's office. Make sure to close the front door.

### SIDE GATE:

This gate is locked for your child's safety and will only be used by staff members.

#### DEPARTURE TIME:

The front door opens strictly at 12:30. All transport arrangements, lift clubs etc., are the responsibility of the parents and the school does not involve itself in any such matters. The school must be notified in writing about any such changes in transport arrangements. Children become distressed when they are being fetched late. Please phone in if you are running late. Children will be taken to aftercare at 12:40 when parents are late and you will be charged the aftercare rate. R50 for late pick-ups, per 15 min.

#### ILLNESS:

NO CHILD WHO IS ILL MAY BE SENT TO SCHOOL. No medication may be administered by staff - if such treatment is required, you are asked to please keep the child at home. Infectious /contagious diseases must be reported and a doctor's certificate is requested for clearance. Children with pink eyes, ring worm or lice/nits are to be kept home and treated until the doctor thinks it is safe to return to school.



### **REFRESHMENTS:**

Parents provide healthy snacks for snack time at 10h00 and for aftercare at 14h30. Ask your teacher for guidance. Aftercare pupils will receive a cooked meal and juice at 12h30. Healthy food is important. From Monday to Thursday we will only allow healthy food. No sweets, chips, biscuits etc. will be allowed. Only on a Friday we will allow treats like sweets, chips etc. They may bring chips and biscuits for aftercare snack time, but not during morning snack time.

### COOLER BAG

We sell a school cooler bag at the office if you wish to purchase it for your child. For the Purple class it is compulsory to have it, but for the rest of the children it is optional. (R150)

### SCHOOL T-SHIRT:

We sell different colour school T-shirts at the front office which you may purchase for your child to wear. (R150)

### BAGS AND COOLER BAGS:

Please make sure the bag and cooler bag you buy for your child is big enough to fit everything that is needed to spend the day at school. School bags must be big enough to carry 2 sets of extra clothes, underwear, jackets, jerseys and shoes. The cooler bag must contain a lunch box and cold drink bottle, a fruit and yogurt. If your child is attending aftercare, please send an extra lunch box for the afternoon snack at 14h30.

## **Clothing and Miscellaneous Rules**

All clothing and shoes must be clearly marked with your child's name. Children must be dressed in suitable play clothes. Clothing which is not allowed to get dirty or place restrictions on a child's play and learning experience should not be worn to school. Please dress your child in clothes they can put on and take off by themselves. Please include two extra sets of weather appropriate clothing in your child's bag in case of small accidents. Please pack a plastic bag in your child's bag for wet clothes. The school will not be held responsible for lost shoes and clothing. It has to be marked with your child's name please.



## IMPORTANT RULE:

No toys, soft toys, books or jewellery may be brought to school. It causes havoc and tears. As teachers we urge that you adhere to this rule as we are not responsible for any loss.

### **BIRTHDAY RINGS:**

These are celebrated at school and we ask that you organize with your child's teacher when your child's birthday is nearly due. Each child will celebrate his/her birthday with his/her own group and you should please send either a large **square/rectangle** cake or cupcakes.

The teacher cannot cut a normal round cake into 20 pieces, it is very difficult. Please do not send 2L cold drinks. Rather send juice boxes for each individual child. You may also send party packs for each child if you so wish. The birthday ring takes place during 10h00 snack time. Please send everything when you bring your child to school as we cannot do the ring later than 10h00.

### SYMBOLS:

Each child has his/her own hook and symbol for their school bag. This develops the child's self-identification and sense of responsibility.

#### BAKERSDAY:

Every Wednesday is Bakers day. The teacher works out a list in the beginning of the term for each child to get a turn to be the baker. The teacher dresses the child in the baker outfit and the rest of the class come and buy with play-play money the baker's treats. Please do not send big cakes for baker day, rather cupcakes, chips or any homemade treats.

### THE NOTEBOOK SYSTEM

The school will provide a notebook with a plastic cover. The cover will remain the property of the school, so please make sure to look after the notebook as it will be given back at the end of the year. Should you lose the book you will be asked to pay a levy of R150 for the cover. Note books for the 3  $\hat{a} \in$  6-year-old children are for school letters only. Only the baby class and toddlers in the purple junior class get their notebooks daily.

#### TERMS

We are a pre-primary school and therefore our terms coincide with those of the school calendar of the KZN EDUCATION DEPARTMENT. (we do however offer holiday care)

## PLEASE MAKE SURE THAT YOU USE YOUR CHILD'S NAME AS REFERENCE

If you do not use your child's name, the accounts department will not be able to allocate the payment to your child's account. We are rendering a service to you and your child. School fees are therefore compulsory. This is the agreement. Port Natal Pre-Primary pay salaries to people for a service they deliver to your child. We cannot do it for free, because no teacher will work for free. It is very important for parents to understand this concept. As humane and loving as we would like to be: IT CANNOT WORK ANY OTHER WAY. No payment No school !! Please avoid a situation where the secretary has to phone parents and ask for the school fee. Parents, please do not make your own payment decisions regarding school fees, like skipping a month and paying double the next month. We have a budget and if parents make their own decisions regarding payment of school fees it affects the management of the school and our own commitments.



## Payment of monies:

All monies pertaining to your child have to be sent to school in a marked envelope with your child's name, correct amount included and what it is for. No money will be accepted if not clearly marked. No change will be given for incorrect amounts.

## Stationary list

Each age group has their own stationary list. Once your child has been allocated to his/her class, you will be able to order the stationary package from the school. Prices are available at the front office.

## Aftercare:

If your child is going to attend aftercare, the following items are compulsory.

Sheet and sheet bag (available at the front office)

Please send a blanket which will also fit into the sheet bag. Your child comes to school with their aftercare bag and it goes home on a Friday for you to wash. On a Monday morning you send it back to school for the week.
